

**Unique Opportunity For The Alumni.
Matching Funds From A Camp Alumnus!
First the Project:**

The Camp Eberhart Alumni Association is undertaking another major project in 2010. Like 2009, we will be constructing retaining walls, but this time, behind the Boat House and all the Low Road Stone Cabins.

Boat House Project: A retaining wall will be built five feet from the back of the building to allow easy clean out every fall. The path behind the Boat House will be re-enforced and the grounds around the building will be re-landscaped. Along with this project, the front of the Wolf Den (Boats and Canoes) will be re-landscaped as will the parking lot in front of Morris Lodge.



Stone Cabins on the Low Road: The ground behind each of the low road cabins is up to the back window ledge. The plan is to cut a five foot path behind each cabin down to the foundation level. The cleaned out area will allow for easy fall clean up and the retaining wall will keep the hill from moving back against the buildings.



Funding:

The Alumni Association has been approached by the Parshall Family from Eugene, Oregon (who are long time Alumnus) with the idea of using a matching grant to fund this project. The donor will match each dollar for dollar [up to \$10,000]. That means by **just joining the Alumni Association**, we can match your dollars with the donors and we can get this project done before summer (dues dollars count for the match). The materials alone will cost close to \$10,000. So, you can see how important this matching money will be. In order to raise additional funds, benches like those on the waterfront will be sold and placed by the chapel and by the Boat House facing the lake.
